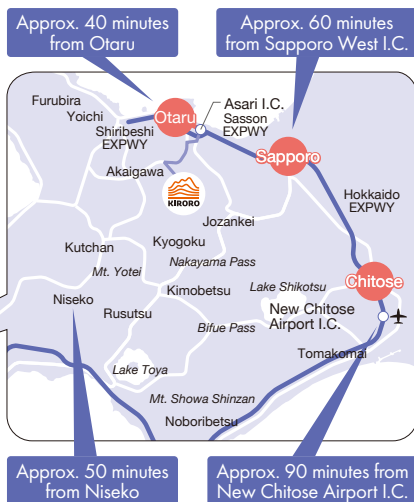

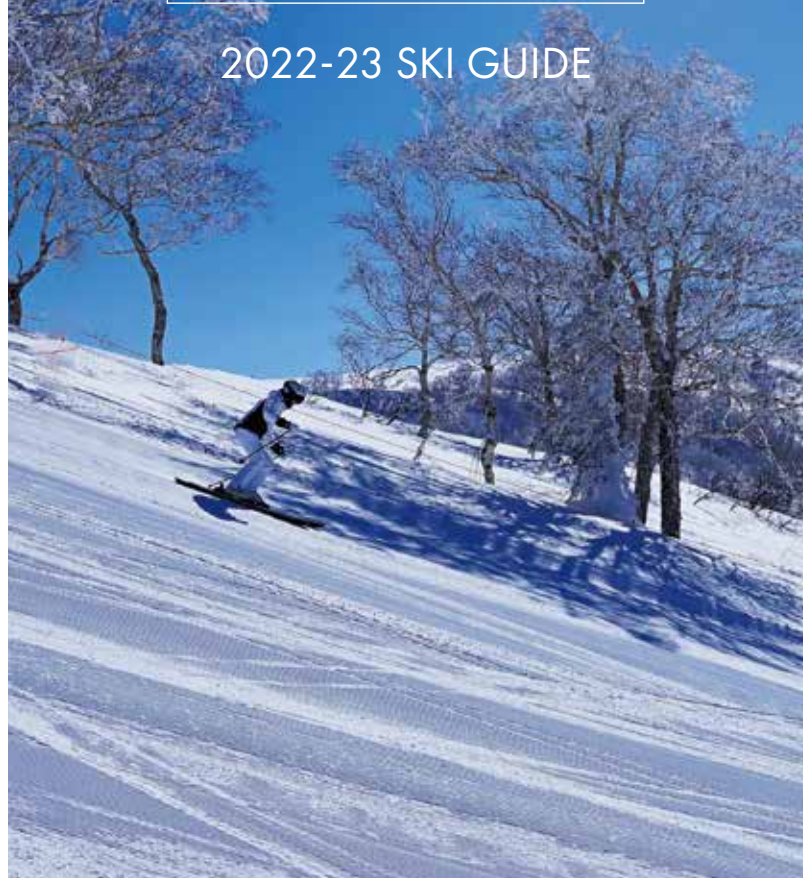

## Kiroro Resort Cares Notice



Kiroro Resort has taken the following COVID-19 preventive measures in accordance with the guidelines provided by the Ministry of Health, Labor and Welfare, and recommendations from local authorities and the Hokkaido government.

Keep customers informed

- Upon check in, guests are required to have their body temperature taken and their travel history reviewed.
- \* We kindly ask that guests understand and follow the new service policy and preventive measures to maintain public personal health. According to the Local Health Center, if a guest's body temperature is 37.5/99.5 or higher, we reserve the right to temporarily suspend any and all accommodations. For guests feeling unwell, we kindly ask for their understanding and cooperation in refraining from participating in activities to help prevent the spread of infection.
- All facilities and equipment will be thoroughly disinfected on a regular basis. Alcohol disinfectant has been installed at Mountain Center entrance, restrooms, and other public spaces.
- Floor markings have been put in place to provide a clear guideline for appropriate social distancing. A clear plastic sheet has also been put up at the check in counter to prevent transmission of the disease via coughing and sneezing.
- All gondolas will be thoroughly disinfected prior to each ride.
- High temperature cleaning of tableware and cutlery, as well as disinfecting of food trays will be done regularly.
- We will closely monitor and manage all health and hygiene standards of our hotel staff based on the Hokkaido Government regulations below:
  - Wear masks -Wash hands frequently -Practice social distancing -Sneeze /cough into elbow

- In the Tree run areas, we want people to truly enjoy skiing/snowboarding on the untouched winter slopes. Therefore, we do not groom, maintain or take any safety precautions against trees or obstacles.
- Please understand that there are risks, difficulties and obstacles above and beyond the normal ski slopes.
- You are to take full responsibility for your safety in this area.
- We do not assume any responsibility as a ski resort for any accidents or injuries that may occur in this area. Please consider your own skills before making the decision to use this advanced course.
- The area is open from 9:00AM until 2:30PM. However it can be closed at the discretion of our patrol depending on conditions or weather.
- Signboards are marked at all entrances so please follow the instructions on these signs.
- This course is for advanced skiers and snowboarders only. Unaccompanied small children must refrain from using the area.
- If you need to request rescue for yourself or others while on the Tree run or back country area, our company will charge you or the others in your party for the rescue.
- Additionally, if public services (fire department or police) request we undertake a rescue, we will charge you for those rescue fees as well.
- Prohibited areas are roped off in order to prevent accidents.
- Please follow the rules and do not go beyond the ropes per regulation and safety rules of the ski resort.

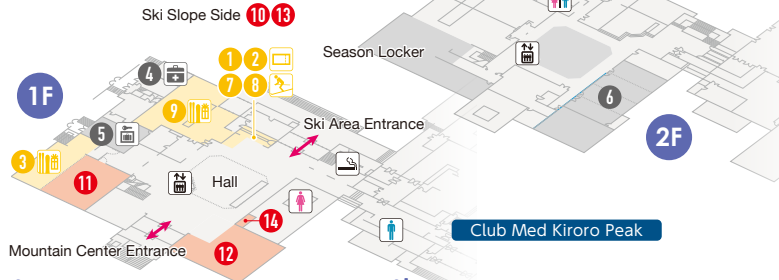
